



Week 1: The Egg Drop Challenge



Your Objective:

Drop an egg from as high as possible without breaking it.

You CAN:

- Protect, wrap or encase the egg however you want to.
- Create a way to slow its descent (for example: a parachute).

You CAN'T:

- Cushion the landing (for example: no dropping onto pillows or into water).
- Interfere with its descent in any way. Once you drop the egg you have to stand back and let gravity do its work.

Once you can drop the egg without breaking it, see how high you can go. If you are successful at the highest height you can safely manage, then get creative and see how far you can launch it without breaking it!

How to avoid angry parents:

DO:

- Explain the challenge before you start.
- Ask if you can use a few eggs. Make sure they are not an ingredient in your next meal.
- Practice with a plastic egg filled with sand or rocks.
- Clean up after yourself and wash your hands.

DON'T:

- Try this inside.
- Make your parents buy dozens of eggs.
- Throw them at or drop them on your siblings or anyone else.
- Drop the egg from your roof or anywhere else really dangerous.



Take a video of your successful egg drop.

Create a video of your solution. Try to keep your video under 1-minute long and include the following:

- The name of your solution.
- How does it work?
- What kind of materials did you use?
- Did you have any problems figuring out the solution?
- What was the biggest lesson you learned?
