Can you capture the wind more efficiently? Can you use less wind to accomplish the same task? Can you accomplish a different type of task? 	
Our tips to avoid angry parents	
DON'T	DO:
 Put your fan on high power so everything goes flying. Go out into a tornado to test your device. Use dangerous sources of wind - like a leaf blower. 	 Keep electric powered wind sources away from water. Keep any manufactured wind away from other people. Clean up after yourself.

- The name of your solution.
- How does it work?
- What kind of materials did you use?
- Did you have any problems figuring out the solution?
- What was the biggest lesson you learned?
