Our tips to avoid angry parents 😀	
DO:	

DON'T Use someone else's things without asking. Leave machine parts all over the stairs or anywhere else. Build your machine at the table right before lunch. Clean up after yourself. Ask permission to build your machine where you want to. Agree on materials to use before you start building.



Create a video of your Rube Goldberg Machine.

Try to keep your video under 1-minute long and include the following:

- The name of your solution.
- How does it work?
- What kind of materials did you use?
- Did you have any problems figuring out the solution?
- What was the biggest lesson you learned?
