

Week 5: Protect the Pringle



Complete the Challenge.

Your goal this week is to protect a Pringle from a falling weight. It cannot crack, crumble, or be eaten by your sibling.

The Rules FOR KIDS 12 AND UNDER	
You CAN:	You CAN'T:
✓ You can use anything as a weight and drop the weight from any height.	You can't just replace your Pringle if it breaks in the middle of your video.
✓ You can use any kind of chip, as long as it's fragile.	X Don't just make a box or place a pre-made box or cup on top of your chip.
✓ You can protect the chip in any way. Get creative!	X You can't interfere with the weight once it's started falling. So no blocking the chip or catching the weight with your hand.
Once you have good protection for the Pringle, see how much weight you can add until it no longer works. Then see if you can improve the solution to withstand even more weight!	
Our tips to avoid angry parents 😀	
DON'T	DO:
 Don't leave Pringles or crumbs everywhere. Don't drop the weight on your toe or anyone else's toe. Don't eat all of your chips. 	 Make sure to keep your chips away from pets and siblings. Be careful with the weight you are dropping on your contraption.
	e Put something under your Pringle. If it gets smashed, it will be easier to clean up.

- How does your solution work?
- What materials did you use?
- Did you have to overcome any problems?
